Increasing font size in the browser

To increase the size of fonts on Internet Explorer, View > Text Size.

To increase the size of fonts in Firefox, View > Text Size > Increase Font, or use the keyboard shortcut by pressing Control and +.

To increase the size of fonts on Opera, View > Preferences > Fonts and change Minimum Font Size (pixels).
